As part of its ministry, Waterford Mennonite Church provides financial assistance to students choosing to attend Mennonite schools at the middle school, high school, college/university, and seminary levels. Eligibility for assistance is described on the attached sheet.

Waterford intends to provide 65 percent of the cost of tuition for students at Bethany Christian Schools, 20 percent of the cost of tuition for the undergraduate studies at the schools listed above, and 30 percent of the cost of tuition at Associated Mennonite Biblical Seminary and Eastern Mennonite Seminary. The amount of support is subject to the total amount committed by the congregation through the process of developing the congregation's spending plan.

To be eligible for financial assistance, students should complete the reverse side of this form and submit it to the church office by February 27. **Students must re-apply for assistance each year.**
