Una and Felton have become familiar faces at Waterford over the past two years, beginning with visits to stay with their daughter, Jane Ross Richer, and her family. Four months ago they became residents of Waterford Crossing, where Una lives in their apartment and Felton has more recently moved to memory care in the Legacy Lane Unit. They are both members of the Berean Sunday School Class and like to join in other activities when possible, including those connected with the Ecuador Two Way Mission Partnership. At Waterford Crossing Felton sometimes attends a men's Bible




Study and enjoys listening to the Bible on CD since his eyesight has deteriorated. This is their first experience of being regular attenders at a Mennonite Church, after previously being active members of a Baptist Church in Greenville, South Carolina, which became their community and church home for about 30 years until 2015.

Originally from the UK—Felton from the West of England, and Una from Scotland—they met during the course of medical missionary work, introduced by Una's sister and Felton's brother, who also married each other! They spent significant time in Nigeria, India and Ethiopia over the course of more than 20 years, sometimes in assignments that overlapped with this same sister and brother and enabled a close relationship to continue. During these years, in addition

to raising five children (four sons and Jane), Una had opportunity to use her skills as a nurse midwife while Felton worked primarily in Leprosy treatment and
