# Lenten worship - "Show us"

With our Ash Wednesday service on the evening of Feb. 26 (7 p.m., after a 6:00 pancake supper provided by the JYF), we once again usher in the season in the church year called Lent. Lent is a time to slow down and breathe in the life of Jesus, as we prepare ourselves for the experience of the suffering, death and resurrection of our Lord. In this season of the year we especially focus on the ministry and saving work of Jesus Christ.

If we pay careful attention Jesus shows us who he is. At different points in the story, Jesus invites us into a deeper understanding or relationship with him. Hence, the theme for our worship services in Lent this year is, "Show us", because we desire for Jesus to show us who he is and who we are. The Scriptures this year demonstrate that Jesus wants to be revealed in new and deeper ways to his church. Our desire is for the church to fall in love again with the story of Jesus. One way we will receive and "show" this message is by learning a key phrase each week that we can "say" using American Sign Language.

Facilities and Finance has reviewed updated January financial information and thanks everyone for your continued generosity in your monetary gifts. Our giving as of January 31 is \$18,098 less than where we would like to be. At this rate, giving will be \$24,131 below budget by year end. To make up for this, our giving for this quarter (February, March, & April) would need to increase by 12%. Another update will be given in an early March Buzz.
