## **Prairie View Support**

On Friday, August 6, Waterford provided a breakfast for the teachers at Prairie View on their second teacher work day as well as the office staff and custodians. There were eleven people who provided food, which was very well received. Fancheon Resler also provided table decorations, including several flower arrangements made with flowers from her garden. Our next event will be providing treats for the entire work force in February, a group that numbers about ninety-five people. As we get closer to the event, there will be suggestions for how you may help with this.

Also, this is a reminder that Prairie View can use boxes of facial tissues for use in the classrooms, underwear in sizes 4-8 for boys and girls (can be used items but should be very clean), and sweatpants with elastic waistbands in sizes 4-10 (gently used). There are plastic tubs at church near the office and the north door for these items to be placed, or you can take them directly to the school if that is more convenient.

A final way that Waterford is supporting Prairie View is through our church budget. We offer a \$500 support fund each semester for special projects that directly benefit the children. Marge Gingerich is the school counselor who oversees this fund which has been used in a variety of ways, such as ear phones, transportation for field trips, computer pens, and other things not covered by the Goshen Community Schools budget but support the students' learning.

As you can see our church along with Maple City Chapel and Adulam, support the staff and the students in beneficial ways that are always greatly appreciated and well received. Your prayers for the school, the teachers and the students, along with their families, are also an appreciated request.
