"Building the Church Back Up": A Fall Worship Series

Our worship series this fall is meant to help us look at the question, "What does it mean to be church?" Behind that is the wondering, "How do we build the church back up?" after significant disruptions and losses of people in our second COVID year.

To address these questions, we will turn to the book of Ephesians, a letter to a first century congregation in Asia Minor about how to be church, even in difficult times. The series roughly follows the order of the text in the epistle, with periodic breaks for special Sundays, such as "singing the salvation story", World Communion Sunday, and our annual All Saints Day observance. Those attending will be given the chance to complete this sentence: "The church is

_____", with those responses brought together later in the series.

Here are a few practicalities to note. Two of these Sundays are planned to be outdoors in and around the pavilion: September 12 and 26. The former is to avoid greater COVID transmission risk with an indoor service of mostly singing in a service which will also have a brief dedication for the pavilion itself. The latter will facilitate access to our baptismal pond. On those two Sundays, we will open windows and doors of the south fellowship hall, as an option for our older adults or those with mobility issues.

In preparation, we invite the congregation to read through the entire book of Ephesians before September 5. The following table summarizes elements of the series that are known at this time:

Amigo Centre Welcomes Volunteers for Storm Cleanup

While many of us in Goshen were sitting without electricity for a day or two after the August 9 storm, the area around Sturgis, Mich., was heavily damaged by fallen trees. Amigo Centre lost hundreds of trees—by one estimate, more than 500—two cabins, one cottage and many other buildings damaged. It will be months of cleanup--and they can't do it without volunteer help.

You, your family, small group or Sunday school class are welcome to volunteer for anywhere from a couple of hours to a whole day. Tasks include chain-sawing, clearing tree branches, raking trails, managing bonfires of smaller tree debris and more. The camp will be taking volunteers next week on Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday. The cleanup is under the Mennonite Disaster Service umbrella for liability purposes. Volunteering will mean filling out a form for MDS upon arriving at the camp.
