

Communion with Pastor Neil

Our quarterly "winter" communion service at Waterford will be set up with a different twist this month. In light of high COVID numbers that may keep some people away from a traditional communion service on Sunday morning, and as one of my last priestly roles as a pastor here, I invite you to join me sometime on Thursday, Jan. 27 for a brief and intimate time of the Lord's Supper in very small groups. I will be prepared at five times throughout that day for up to 10 Waterford people at a time to share in an informal communion service with me and one or two helpers in the sanctuary. There will be some common times of prayer, music, Scripture and reflection as we sit masked and spaced apart. I will offer communion to one individual or household at a time with no lines of people. I would like to offer each of you, before I conclude my pastorate, a personal blessing when you receive the bread and cup.

On Sundays the 16th and 23rd there will be a sign-up sheet in the foyer for up to 10 people at each of the following times: 7:00 a.m., 10:00 a.m., 12:30 p.m., 3:00 p.m. and 6:00 pm. You may also call or email Janet in the church office to reserve your spot. Each communion service will last only 15 to 20 minutes. Although these times mostly fall within the regular school day, I will also have grapes and crackers for any unbaptized or still discerning persons who want to come. I'm grateful to my fellow pastors for this creative idea, and look forward to these holy moments together.
