As part of its ministry, Waterford Mennonite Church provides financial assistance to students choosing to attend Mennonite schools at the middle school, high school, college/university, and seminary levels. Eligibility for assistance is described on the attached sheet.

The amount of support allocated to families is subject to the total amount available in the budget for the Mennonite Education Fund. Waterford's policy provides up to 65 percent of the cost of tuition for students at Bethany Christian Schools, up to 20 percent of the cost of tuition for undergraduate studies at the schools listed above, and up to 30 percent of the cost of tuition at Associated Mennonite Biblical Seminary and Eastern Mennonite Seminary. If applications exceed funds available in the Waterford Budget, student aid will be reduced to the amounts available. Waterford encourages families to apply for financial aid at all institutions, including Bethany, to supplement the support Waterford is able to provide.

To be eligible for financial assistance, students should complete page two of this form and submit it to the church office by February 28. Students must re-apply for assistance each year.
